## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The home health criteria:

1. Be essentially homebound, but not necessarily bedridden, and needing assistance when leaving home.
2. Needs intermittent skilled care that are medically reasonable and necessary.
3. Under the care of an M.D.

All patients are accepted for care regardless of race, color, sex, national origin, religion, age or disability.
